

Regular Meeting-City Council
January 7, 2019 @ 7:00 p.m.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Millersburg was held Monday, January 7, 2019 at 7:00 pm at the Civic Center. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hopkins. Roll call was taken with following present: Penny Barbee, Kevin Hopkins, Ethan Jackson, Michael Jackson, and Lorrain Smoot. Rick Wagoner came in later.

Councilman Hopkins made motion to approve minutes. Second by Councilman E. Jackson. Motion carried with four aye votes and one abstain vote from Councilwoman Barbee.

There were no public comments.

Committee Reports:

Fire & Public Safety-No report.

Annexation-Pat Darnell still has some work to do on Phase II. Sent a preliminary plat and list of total acreage for each property.

Office & General Fund-Work on delinquent taxes.

Streets & Trash-Ford truck back in operation.

Parks-Time to take down lights in Square.

Civic Center-Boxing ring to be removed. Boiler is cracked and leaking water. Mayor Hopkins and Councilman Hopkins are to look at boiler and see if it is feasible to repair.

Attorney Brannon gave report on vacant, blighted and abandoned properties. Corman property to come up in February. There is a buyer for Alberta Carter properties. Lawsuit is ready to file. Attorney is to work with perspective buyer. Councilwoman Smoot made motion to proceed with abatement. Second by Councilman Hopkins. Motion carried with six aye votes. Attorney is to mail letter to Mid-South on Bessie Stone property.

Motion made by Councilwoman Smoot to discuss Phase I annexation. Second by Councilwoman Barbee. Motion carried with six aye votes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Barbee to approve second reading of Phase I Annexation Ordinance. Second by Councilman M. Jackson. Motion carried with six aye votes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Barbee to approve second reading of ordinance setting meeting dates for 2019. Second by Councilman Wagoner. After discussion, motion made by Councilman Hopkins to amend ordinance to add eight additional meetings, February-October on February 18, March 18, April 15, May 20, July 15, August 19, September 23, and October 21. Second by Councilman M. Jackson. Motion carried with five aye votes. One no vote from Councilman Wagoner. 
All work is to be done in accordance with plans, specifications and conditions provided in the contract.
